- Feb 7** **"Till The Clouds Roll By"** Starring Judy Garland (1946) - NR, 136 min
Jerome Kern is profiled in this musical biography - composer of Academy Award winning tunes "The Last Time I Saw Paris" and "The Way You Look Tonight."
- Feb 14** **"The Lost Valentine"** Starring Betty White (2011) - PG, 100 min
Caroline Thomas loses her beloved husband Neil in WWII. Every year on the anniversary of the day they said goodbye, she makes a pilgrimage to Union Station to salute the memory of the time they enjoyed together.
- Feb 21** **"San Francisco"** Starring Clark Gable, Jeanette MacDonald (1936) - NR, 115 min
Jeanette plays the belle of San Francisco during the great earthquake.
- Feb 28** **"The Great Caruso"** Starring Mario Lanza, Ann Blyth (1951) - NR, 109 min
A fascinating blend of biographical drama and outstanding music.

The bungler of the Paris Police, Inspector Jacques Clouseau (Sellers), is the sort of man whose wife is not only two-timing him, but is doing so with the very jewel thief he's been assigned to catch.
- March 13** **"Journey for Margaret"** Starring Margaret O'Brien, Robert Young (1942) - NR, 81 min
Stirring WWII drama of children left homeless by British bombing.
- March 20** **"Red River"** Starring John Wayne, Montgomery Clift, (1948) - NR, 133 min
A man and his adopted son are forced to drive cattle an impossible distance on the Chisholm Trail.
- March 27** **"The Hunt For Red October"** Starring Sean Connery, (1990) - PG, 135 min
Marko Ramios (Connery), a Soviet nuclear sub captain, is planning to defect to the U.S. But with the exception of CIA Agent Jack Ryan (Alec Baldwin), the U.S. believes Ramios' plans are of a sinister nature.
- April 3** **"Lost Horizon"** Starring Peter Finch, Liv Ullmann (1973) - G, 144 min
Musical version of a group of travelers whose plane crashes in the Andes and find the beautiful, peaceful society of Shangri-La.
